VIII. MEMBER REFERENDA AND BOG REFERRALS TO MEMBERSHIP

A. MEMBER REFERENDA

- 1. The Board of Governors sets the policy for the Bar. Except for license fees, Tthe membership, through a referendum, has the opportunity to affect policy set by the BOG. Membership referenda may accomplish the following:
 - a. Reverse a final action taken by the Board of Governors; except an action adopting the annual budget or setting the amount of the license fee under Section I.
 - b. Modify a final action taken by the Board of Governors; except for an action setting the amount of the license fee under Section I.
