- EAC Liaison Report
  - Board of Governors to vote on NWLawyer name change on 11/23
    - The Board will vote on 11/23 whether to change NWLawyer back to Washington State Bar News. The magazine name change has been a topic of conversation for the past few months. In July 2019, the Communications and Outreach Department in collaboration with this committee conducted a survey of WSBA members to gather their thoughts on this potential change.
  - The Editorial Advisory Committee asked the EAC Board liaison to convey to the Board that, going forward, the EAC would like to be consulted and involved in issues regarding NWLawyer magazine under discussion by the Board well in advance of any vote being taken so as to be able to provide its feedback to the Board.
  - Open Public Meetings Act (OPMA)
    - EAC needs to be compliant with OPMA. Part of that compliance means posting meeting times, agendas, and minutes online.
    - Electronic Communication under the OPMA emails, social media posts and comments, phone calls, and text messages may be construed as a "meeting" if a quorum of members are involved in the communication.
