WSBA-Request Bill Proposal: Corporate Act Revisions Committee, Business Law Section

- Guests Michael Hutchings and Diane Lourdes Dick provided committee members with an overview of the Corporate Act Revisions Committee and the work that they do. They gave a broad explanation about the Model Act and the direction that CARC has been moving Washington in.
- The three areas of interest for this CARC proposal are in preemptive rights, cumulative voting, and a statue that requires shareholder approval in all dispositions involving substantial sales.
- The CARC presenters gave in-depth explanations for their proposal and the committee had a chance to ask questions of the guests.
- Edwin Norton moved that the CARC bill meets GR12.2 Tim Spellman seconded; no objections; passed unanimously.
- Edwin Norton moved that the CARC bill be tabled until the next meeting pending feedback from stakeholders. Tim Spellman seconded; no objections; passed unanimously.

WSBA-Request Bill Proposal: Proposed Amendment to RCW 51.52.120

- Guest Patrick Palace via teleconference provides committee with summary of proposed amendment to RCW 51.52.120.
- Conversation follows regarding the positive effects of the proposed amendment but concern over the lack of stakeholder input and potential collateral effects of the amendment.
- ATJ board to meet Nov. 9 to discuss bill and provided formal written endorsement.
- Edwin Norton proposed moved that bill meets GR 12.2. Tim Spellman seconded; no objections; passed unanimously.
- Edwin Norton moved that the bill be tabled pending input and possible amendments by sections and other stakeholders. John Yip seconded; no objections; passed unanimously.
- Discussion about which stakeholders will be vetted by Patrick Palace.
- Kyle Sciuchetti suggests to Sanjay that he indicate to Patrick Palace a list of organizations to vet.
