## I. ANNUAL LICENSE FEES AND ASSESSMENTS

6. License Fee Referendum

Once approved by the BOG, license fees shall be subject to the same referendum process as other BOG actions, but may not be modified or reduced as part of a referendum on the Bar's budget. The membership shall be timely notified of the BOG resolutions setting license fees both prior to and after the decision, by posting on the Bar's website, e-mail, and publication in the Bar's official publication.

The membership shall be timely notified of the BOG resolutions setting license fees both prior to and after the decision, by posting on the Bar's website, e-mail, and publication in the Bar's official publication. Under GR 12.2(b)(22), the amount of any license fee is subject to review by the Supreme Court for reasonableness and may be modified by order of the Court if the Court determines that the fee is not reasonable. Therefore, license fees are not subject to a referendum, nor may the license fees be modified or reduced as part of a referendum on the Bar's budget.
