In an email dated April 29, 2025, the WSBA notified the Court that there was a scrivener's error in the amendments to the WSBA Bylaws approved by the Court in Order No. 25700-B-724. The WSBA inadvertently failed to change "50 years" to "40 years". The Court reviewed the amendments and finds that "40 years" aligns with the intention of the amendments previously adopted by the Court in Order No. 25700-B-724.

Now, therefore, it is hereby

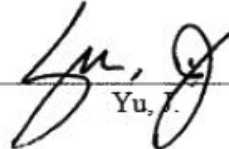
ORDERED:

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E. CHANGE OF MEMBERSHIP STATUS TO INACTIVE
