April Meeting Minutes: The minutes were approved without edits.

WSBA Entity Regulation Pilot: Renata Garcia with the Washington State Bar Association gave an update on the Entity Regulation Pilot Project. It will be a process where entities can become regulated to provide legal service. Some examples include instances where a law firm wants to include non-attorney members in their ownership and nonprofits that want to explore alternative options for delivering civil legal aid. The Court has suggested that the Council on Public Defense review the pilot project and discuss innovative methods for the delivery of criminal defense. Renata addressed questions Kathy Kyle, who manages a nonprofit public defense office, noted that she plans to learn more about the pilot project and will share learnings with the Council.

Standards Update and WSBA Amicus Brief: Jason Schwarz shared that the Court is still reviewing the proposed Standards and we do not have any new information. He also shared that the Washington State Bar Association Board of Governor's were considering whether to submit an amicus brief relating to case pending before the WA Supreme Court, *re Detention of M.E.* Jason and other members of the Council have submitted comments encouraging the Board of Governors to submit the amicus brief. The Board of Governors is considering the request in the next few weeks. The Council discussed the merits of submitting the amicus brief.

Office of Public Defense Legislative Updates: Sophia Byrd McSherry provided a comprehensive overview of the funding decisions from the recent legislative session. She provided a document that displayed the 2025-27 biennial and 2025 supplemental budgets, including the agency's request compared to the actual budget. Sophia highlighted key budget decisions and addressed questions.

Announcements: Maialisa Vanyo reminded members that CPD could send participants to the Access to Justice Conference and encouraged those interested to contact staff. Bob Boruchowitz shared about the June 27 Defender Initiative conference at Seattle University.

Re: PROPOSED EDITS TO WSBA INDIGENT DEFENSE STANDARDS – APPENDIX B

The Appendix B subcommittee proposes the attached changes to Appendix B of the WSBA Indigent Defense Standards for the CPD's consideration and vote. This memo serves as an outline to the changes, though many individual edits will be found only in the attached document.

BACKGROUND

The Committee met in May and June of 2025 to review and update Appendix B.

Our deliberations were led by three factors:

- Adding new crimes or amending existing ones based on new legislation since the last draft
- Revisions to the Appendix B case types for currently listed crimes, if any. The Committee considered the following factors when deciding whether to amend a crimes case type:
 - Attorney time data and other data from jurisdictions suggesting a modification is needed
 - Caseload management concerns, including the concerns to non-lawyer staff and data management systems needed to administer assignments consistent with Appendix B
 - Other considerations
- Corrections/Errors

The Committee considered recommendations from members and non-members alike.

PROPOSED CHANGES

The Committee proposes one large structural change along with seven other smaller changes:

- 1. Create a new case category called "Felony Sex Low" and "Felony Sex High"
 - o 10 Crimes would go from Felony-Sex (5) to Felony Sex Low (3). These class C sex offenses would be worth 3 credits moving forward. The Indecent Liberties sections d,e,f, will go from felony low (1) to Felony Sex Low (3).

o 6 Crimes will go from Felony Sex (5) to a new category of Felony Sex High (6). These indeterminate plus sex offenses would be worth 6 credits moving forward.

- 2. Promoting prostitution 2 (RCW 9A.88.080) would become Felony Low.
 - This is not a sex offense and does not require registration and is a Class C.
 The second or subsequent conviction does have registration so would become Felony Sex and worth 3 credits as referenced above.
- 3. Controlled Substance Homicide (RCW 69.50.415) would become Felony Murder.
 - This is currently listed as Felony Low and be reclassified as Felony Murder to be consistent with all other cases where a death is alleged.
- 4. Criminal Mistreatment 2 (RCW 9A.42.030) Would become Felony Low.
 - o This corrects an error which categorized this crime as Felony Sex
- 5. Sending, bringing into state depictions of minor engaged in sex explicit conduct 1 (RCW 9.68A.060(1) Would become Felony Sex.

 Currently a Felony – Low. Sending 2nd degree is also a Class B sex offense and is already listed as Felony – Sex. From 1 to 5 credits.

6. Municipal Statue case weights

- Currently, the direction in the guidelines indicates that all Municipal crimes shall be in the same case weight as equivalent State crime. If there is no comparable State crime, gross misdemeanor (Misdemeanor High (1.5)) and a simple misdemeanor (Misdemeanor Low ()1). This can result in potentially out of balance caseloads between county and city PD's as potentially more cases would be misdemeanor high in Municipal courts. Since most municipal codes that create new and unique crimes label them as simple misdemeanors, we opted to reclass Municipal Crimes as Misdemeanor Low. This is listed in the chart and at the top of the first page of the chart.
- 7. Trafficking 1 and 2 relabeled based on revised statute.
 - The statute is changing on 7-1-25 and what sections are, and are not, sex offenses is going to be even more confusing. The revisions attempt to provide clarity for practitioners and supervisors.
- 8. Inchoate Sex Offenses will remain sex offense.
 - This change attempts to resolve the confusion of what happens to an inchoate sex offense if it drops to a Case Type that is below what is expected of other sex offense cases. Currently, all inchoate offenses drop a case type from the underlying charge (i.e. a Rape 1 is Felony Sex (6), but attempted Rape 1 is Felony High (3)).
 - The edit retains the same categories but makes an exception for sex offense cases. In those cases, when an inchoate sex offense is charged, the case type remains the same as the underlying crime. (i.e. when a person is charged with a crime categorized as an attempt of a Felony Sex Low, the case remains a Felony Sex Low).
- 9. Minor DUI and Negligent Driving 1st Degree reclassified as Misdemeanor High
 - The cases involved the same types of discovery as DUIs, which are often technical and involving experts and should track the classification of DUI.

REJECTED CHANGES

The Committee considered two edits which were voted down.

The Committee declined to reclassify Burglary 1 as a Felony High.



RE: Advisory opinion regarding excessive public defense caseload

Dear Monte,

As detailed below, I request that the Committee on Professional Ethics (CPE) review its <u>1990 advisory opinion</u> regarding excessive public defense caseloads and issue additional guidance, as appropriate, in light of the <u>WSBA Standards for Indigent Defense Services</u> and the June 9, 2025 Washington Supreme Court <u>order</u>.

For many years, WSBA and the Washington Supreme Court have promulgated practice standards applicable to public defense lawyers. In March 2024, the WSBA Council on Public Defense proposed revisions to the WSBA Standards for Indigent Defense Services, including changes to the maximum caseloads for Washington public defenders. The Council on Public Defense proposed a two-year phased implementation schedule for the new caseloads beginning July 2, 2025. The WSBA Board of Governors adopted the revisions, including the caseload standards and implementation schedule, and forwarded the new WSBA Standards to the Washington Supreme Court with the request that the Court incorporate the updates into the Court's standards.

The Court's June 9, 2025 order adopted the proposed caseload standards effective January 1, 2026. The Court directed that implementation of the caseload standards must be accomplished as soon as reasonably possible, but by no later than ten years from January 1, 2026, and that jurisdictions must make annual reductions in caseloads of at least 10% of the difference between the current and new caseload standards. The differences between the implementation timeline in WSBA's Standards and the timeline adopted by the Court have raised questions among public defense attorneys and administrators regarding their ethical obligations under each set of standards. These attorneys have sought guidance from WSBA.

The CPE's 1990 advisory opinion touched on some of the ethical issues raised by excessive public defense caseloads. That opinion, however, is brief and does not address many aspects of the current circumstances facing public defense attorneys and administrators, including the respective roles of the Court and WSBA standards. I ask that CPE now address the following questions:

- Which Washington Rules of Professional Conduct are implicated by excessive caseloads and how are they implicated?
- What ethical obligations do public defense attorneys and administrators have with respect to the caseload standards in WSBA's Standards for Indigent Defense Services?
- What ethical obligations do public defense attorneys and administrators have with respect to the caseload standards as adopted by the Washington Supreme Court in its June 9, 2025, order?
- What responsibilities does a lawyer have if the lawyer believes that their caseload is excessive?
- When assigning cases to public defense attorneys, what are the ethical responsibilities of supervisors and administrators? If an attorney communicates to their supervisor that they cannot fulfill their ethical responsibilities under their caseload, what steps must a supervisor take? What ethical considerations are implicated if an employer seeks to discipline an attorney for refusing to accept additional clients?

Thank you for your attention to this important matter. Your guidance will greatly assist the public defense community in better understanding their ethical obligations with respect to Washington's caseload standards.
