PUBLIC SESSION

Call to Order / Preliminary Matters

The meeting was called to order at 1:05 p.m. by Chair Nancy Ivarinen.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The Board approved the proposed minutes for the January 20, 2022 meeting.

Outreach and Press Update

Nancy Ivarinen discussed NY Times Article "They Need Legal Advice on Debts. Should it Have to Come From Lawyers," which discusses the need for consumer representation by non-lawyers relating to debt issues.



Update on Status of LLLT Exam

The WSBA liaison provided the status on the grading of the January 25-26, 2022 LLLT Exam.

<u>Update on TAXICAB (Task Force Team Administering Xenial Involvement with Court Appointed Boards)</u>

Steve Crossland, the TAXICAB Committee Chair, provided an update on the alternate proposal to the TAXICAB proposed memorandum regarding the interpretation of GR 12.3. Steve Crossland and other proponents of the alternate proposal are scheduled to meet discuss and the issues on February 8, 2022. The board discussed the implications of the TAXICAB proposals given the recent discussions by the Board of Governors on whether the WSBA will remain an integrated bar.

Family Law Practice Area Committee Update

Jennifer Ortega provided the status of the committee's development of a real property form for use by LLLTs. The committee anticipates that the new form will be submitted for comment and discussion at the March or April 2022 LLLT Board meetings.

Nicole Searing presented a one-hour CLE on the new guardianship procedures.

Other Miscellaneous Matters.

Nancy Ivarinen discussed the issue of whether to seek an amendment to APR 28 to reduce the number of board members on the LLLT Board, given the Supreme Court's order sunsetting the LLLT Program. The Nominations Committee will be reviewing these issues. The board will also consider amending APR 28 to add nonparental guardianships to replace the provisions authorizing LLLTs to provide services relating to nonparental custody because the statute authorizing nonparental custody has been repealed and replaced by guardianship statutes. The staff liaison will discuss budget and audit issues with Steve Crossland. The board will discuss whether the April 11, 2022 LLLT Meeting will be an in-person meeting at the March 14, 2022 LLLT meeting.
