<u>Family Law Practice Area Committee</u>: This Committee reviews the APR and the scope of the Family Law Practice Area. It suggests changes to scope and identifies and prepares required supplemental education based on changes in the permitted scope of practice for LLLTs. This committee is responsible for maintaining the bank of forms approved by the LLLT Board, including drafting and recommending new forms as needed. (Jennifer Ortega, COMMITTEE CHAIR).

<u>Discipline Committee</u>: The Committee is governed by and performs the functions described in the Rules for Enforcement of Limited License Legal Technician Conduct (ELLLTC) and those delegated by the LLLT Board Chair. The Committee is 3-5 members appointed by the LLLT Board Chair, who does not serve on the Committee. Non-board members may be appointed by the Court as requested by the LLLT Board Chair. (Nancy Ivarinen, COMMITTEE CHAIR).

<u>Nominations Committee</u>: The Committee reviews applications for LLLT Board positions. As necessary, the Committee recruits applicants for Board positions and drafts any needed changes to rules regarding Board composition. (Ted Cropley, COMMITTEE CHAIR).

<u>Limited License Review Committee</u>: This Committee will examine the LLLT license. It will explore what is going well, what could be improved, and will research and gather information on what other states and countries are doing with respect to limited licenses. The Committee will liaison with other Boards, Committees, and entities. The information gathered will be used to prepare a report. (TBD, COMMITTEE CHAIR).
