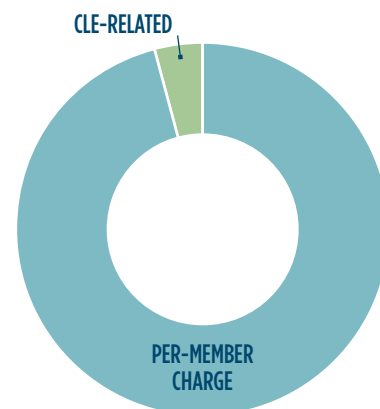
- Held a Mini-CLE virtually and sponsored a writing competition that awarded financial scholarships to several law students in Washington.
