

## MEETING MINUTES WSBA – Civil Rights Law Section February 15, 2021 (DRAFT)

- 1. Motion to Amend the December 30, 2020 Retreat minutes. Approved.
- 2. CRLS 2021 Values. Approved and will be published on CRLS website.
- 3. Legislative Research Committee (LRC) Update.
  - Welcome to Christine Ybarra, new member of CRLS/volunteer on the LRC.
  - Virtual Happy Hour on February 24, 2021.
  - Felony Voting Rights Bill: HB 1078
    - i. GR 12 letter supporting this legislation was drafted last year.
    - ii. EC approves (1) continued support of this bill and (2) that the position articulated in the letter satisfies GR 12 criteria.
  - Tobin distributed LRC Statement summarizing LRC duties:
    - i. Tobin will add a line re: LRC's obligation to track past research/drafting efforts of the EC if/when such efforts become relevant during current legislative session.
    - ii. Today is the deadline for the Policy Committee. Next Monday is the next deadline for Fiscal Committee (Appropriations).
  - <u>Issue</u>: LRC does not receive adequate updates on "tracked" bills for EC to take position statements on.
    - Alec will follow up with WSBA/BOG and Cameron will follow up with Russell to improve this part of the process.
    - Stephan will create separate Gmail address to be able to sign up for our own updates in the meantime.
    - o LRC will meet to decide next steps as to email.
- **4.** Community Outreach Committee Outreach Efforts. The CCC is creating a list of community contacts that we will engage with this coming year. The first will be AIDNW who will offer a presentation on their organization. We hope to incorporate this presentation into a CRLS virtual Happy Hour.

- **5. Diploma Privilege Letter Updates.** Moot issue since Supreme Court of Washington State has spoken.
- **6. Honoring Black History Month on Listserv.** EC should work collectively to distribute materials celebrating Black History to CRLS all month long.
- 7. Equity and Diversity Task Force Update. The Task Force has prioritized two areas to work on:
  - (1) draft changes to GR 12 to try to make the Rule less of a stumbling block when Sections want to weigh in on various matters (Laura Sierra is subcommittee chair); and
  - (2) remove impediments to access to legal system for low-income folks and POC folks (Kim Sander is the subcommittee chair).
