The WSBA Civil Rights Section Executive Committee met by phone November 29, 2018.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and approve the Section's article for *Northwest Lawyer* in commemoration of Martin Luther King Day, drafted by Jill Mullins and revised by Kristi Kruz

A quorum of six Section Executive Committee was present to discuss the draft article.

The members generally approved the substance of the article with its themes: ending institutional violence, correcting disproportionate discipline, eliminating the school to prison pipeline, and ending the opportunity gap, with the aim of actualizing Dr. King's vision. Minor grammatical and formatting changes were made in the draft.

Sarah moved that the committee approve submission of the article as drafted to *Northwest Lawyer* with the exception of minor typographical corrections or revisions deemed necessary by WSBA, and submission to the committee's attorney for review. The motion was seconded and members present voted unanimously to approve the article as drafted.
