Item 1: Petition for Rulemaking Re: Home Equity Limit.

The Committee held a vote via email, but the vote is held again in this meeting to comply with WSBA guidance:

Each voting member considered two issues:

FIRST: Does the proposed amendment satisfy GR 12.2?

SECOND: Should the Section support Seattle University School of Law's petition for rulemaking to raise the WA state home equity limit for long term care services eligibility from the current lowest amount possible—\$603,000—to the highest amount—\$906,000?
