- Collaborated with other sections to produce and co-sponsor CLE content with broader appeal across sections.

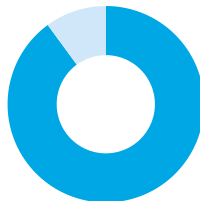
