The Washington State Supreme Court considered the request by the Limited License Legal Technician (LLLT) Board to authorize the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) to offer the LLLT licensure examination on dates after July 31, 2021. This request is based on the unprecedented size of the cohort of LLLT candidates currently completing the educational requirements, the short window of time between the end of Spring 2021 classes and the currently scheduled examination in July 2021, and the additional efforts needed to provide appropriate disability accommodations. A majority of the court approved entry of the following order.

Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That WSBA is authorized to administer additional LLLT examinations after July 31, 2021, with the understanding that all LLLT candidates must still complete all requirements for licensure no later than July 31, 2022, in order to be licensed as a LLLT.
